



COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

The Barnstable Comedy Club remains committed to the health and safety of our community. As such, BCC is implementing safety measures to ensure a safe and enjoyable theater going experience for our patrons, staff, volunteers, and artists. BCC adheres to all requirements and regulations set forth by the State of Massachusetts and the CDC including but not limited to; observing social distancing, limited capacity, requiring masks or facial coverings and requiring proof of vaccination.

As of March 8, 2022

Proof of vaccination will be required.

Masks are optional but no longer required to be worn during the entire performance.

Upon arrival and before you enter the theater, all guest MUST present proof that they have been fully vaccinated as defined by the CDC. COVID at-home tests are unacceptable. Either the physical card or a digital photo of the card must be shown. ALL guests within a party must show proof of vaccination.

Guests who are exempt from COVID-19 due to medical reasons or religious beliefs MUST show proof of a negative COVID test result taken within a 72-hour period before entering the theater.

Please be advised that facial coverings may be required during performances under modified local, state and/or federal government guidance.

If you are feeling sick, we encourage you NOT to attend the performance and to call the Box Office to reschedule your tickets for a later date. Hand Sanitizer stations have been conveniently placed at key points in the theater for continued disinfecting and cleanliness.

Cast and crew members, staff, and patrons must not have any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19 or Variants:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19

We continue to listen, learn and evolve to keep our theater a comfortable and safe environment for our patrons, artists and staff.
