CANASTA TABLE RULES and BASIC SCORING

1. You play 3 hands with each person at your table with the following meld:

First - 125

Second - 155

Third - 180

- 2. Each person is responsible for recording their score for each hand on the provided score sheet.
- 3. Partners should check to make sure scores are correct before moving to the next partner.
- 4. Score cards will be collected before changing tables.
- 5. Players will rotate from table to table and everyone plays as an individual.... keeping their own scores from game to game.
- 6. No table talk or reminders to take the talon is permitted.
- 7. If you do not remember to take the talon before the other team picks for their turn, the cards are forfeited.
- 8. Talons are NOT placed on the side of the trays and are chosen at the time one melds from the top of the pile.
- 9. Once you lay your meld down, no other movement of cards within your meld is allowed.
- 10. No one can comment on your point count until you discard. If your meld is incorrect, an additional 10 points will be required to meld.
- 11. A wild-card canasta must be completed before wild cards can be used to close other canastas.
- 12. If you pick up the pile with aces and simultaneously meld, they must be completed as natural.
- 13. There will be NO asking to go out.

NO splashes will be played

BASIC SCORING

Ace canasta . . . +2500 points

Sevens canasta . . . +2500 points

Ace or wild card canastas uncompleted . . . -2500

Unmade 7 canasta . . . -2500 points

More than 2 aces or 2 sevens in hand at end of play . . . -1500

All eight 3's . . . +3000

Wild card canasta mixed . . . +2500

Wild card canasta with all 4 big jokers . . . +3000

All deuces canasta . . . +4000

Concealed canasta . . . +5000
