Food & financial donations to feed the hungry are in short supply.

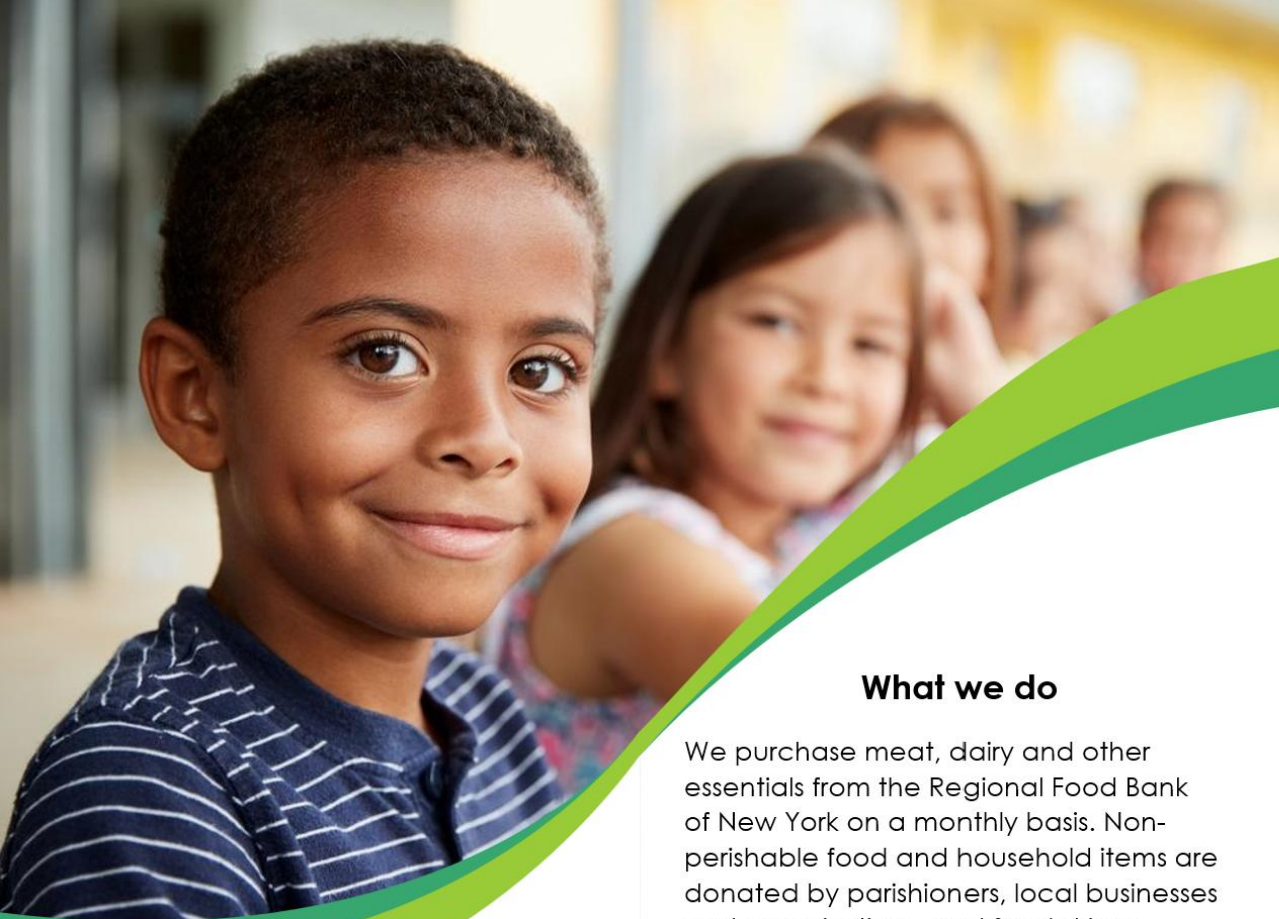
Everyday residents in our community struggle to find affordable and nutritious food for their families.

What we do

We purchase meat, dairy and other essentials from the Regional Food Bank of New York on a monthly basis. Non-perishable food and household items are donated by parishioners, local businesses and organizations, and food drives.

At Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter we provide our clients with a grocery store gift card to purchase their holiday meal. We also provide a gift card at Christmas for all children under 18 years old so the parent/guardian can purchase a special gift for the child.

We collect school supplies in late summer and have available a selection of new coats, hats, and gloves for needy children in the winter.
