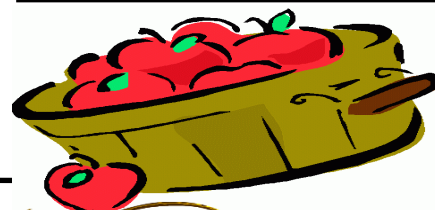

You can pick up a form at any local CCSO building, please note that the form is NOT available online. We also have copies at the front desk for your convenience. You must submit the form to the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office but you can also let the office know the time period which you will be away.

PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM COMING!



Oak Hollow will be reinstating parking permits. More information will be posted as the program rolls out, so be on the look-out for information in the mail. Amendment to Article VIII, adding section 3 to read as follows:

Motor Vehicles. Each residence shall be limited to two(2) motor vehicles.

- A. If a 3rd vehicle is needed, it must be by a licensed family member to drive to and from work or school and **if there is room** to park a 3rd vehicle without interference to a neighbor and without blocking the sidewalk.
- B. Each vehicle is registered to a licensed family member driver. Application for approval of a third vehicle must be made in advance, and approval granted **BEFORE** the vehicle is parked in Oak Hollow.

We will issue parking stickers to all Oak Hollow residents. If you have a guest visit we will also have Guest Parking Permits available for you to get at the office for your guest.




Reminders for the community:

Here are a few helpful reminders to help us all follow the rules of the community:

1. Lawns should be maintained so that they do not reach a height greater than six inches
2. Garbage and recycling containers must be put away within 24 hours of trash/recycle pick-up.
3. Parking of vehicles should be in the garage or driveway. You cannot park on the lawn. Parking in the swale (grassy area between the sidewalk and road) is permitted but only if there is no damage caused to the grounds and that it does not block any sidewalk or driveways.
