Chaplain's Message

Forgiveness

I've been reading a book about Christians suffering at the hands of radical Islamists. I was startled to read the many instances of the one persecuted or the family members of those martyred for their faith in Jesus who seemed to so easily forgive those who had caused the pain. I understood those who wanted vengeance immediately, but I was pleased that they eventually allowed God to soften their hearts to be able to genuinely forgive.

I Corinthians 13:4-8 says, "Love is patient . . . kind . . . not resentful . . . bears all things." Love is an Action. Love is a Choice. Humans don't just forgive naturally; therefore, we need to do what is "super natural" through the power of the Holy Spirit. How easy it is to become offended at the smallest infraction of our rights, but what if WE were really faced with possible martyrdom? As we see how God has worked in these very difficult situations, our responses to those who wrong us even in small ways should be no less than truly loving and forgiving. God helps us to be more Christ-like daily, as we pray for His virtues to show through us. And yes, we will be happier and healthier for it.



We currently have 59 memberships representing 100 Members!



From the Archives....

THE CORT REA

SCHOOL OF OFFENSIVE DRIVING





Or start in the middle and drive the 2nd half only.




Or for the "long haul", the entire route.
