BlueFarm

Laceroni vineyard is nestled in the deep southwestern part of the Russian River Valley close to the town of Graton. The vineyard was planted in the mid-2000's. The cool climate and the typical Goldridge soil give this wine its character. Soft rolling hills, protected from direct sunlight, allow for slow ripening.

Olive, fig and minerality; aromas of beautiful white flowers. An exciting display of rich tropical fruit, with touches of tangerine, nectarine, white peach and citrus.

ORDAZ

Located on Sonoma Mountain, the vineyard is on acres of 30-year-old Malbec vines. Crafting the Malbec closer to the Argentinian style, Ordaz ages the Malbec in lightly seasoned French oak for 18 months before bottling.



AVERAEN

Oregon reminded the wine makers of where the Sonoma Coast was 10-15 years ago in what is now a vineyard that sourcing 10 tons of Pinot Noir from this harvest, talking about the similarities between our cold and foggy Sonoma Coast and the various sub-appellations of the Willamette Valley.

Aromas of ripe red berries, cherry, subtle cola and licorice nuances with bitter cherry and raspberry flavors on the back half. A smoky note emerges on the clinging finish, which features fine-grained tannins and suave red fruit preserve and mocha qualities.



Among the top 5% wines of the world, Smash City Pinot is what 6 foot tires and 1200 hp are to a Prius! Never any talk of rootstock, battonage or micro climates, this wine is just pure pleasure!

Nose is amazing - funky aromatics of mushrooms, dark fruits, candied blueberry, leather, and pound cake. Palate is rich and complex - added notes of dark cherry, dark chocolate, pepper, pencil shaving. This wine is so fruit forward with big and bold cherry on the pallet.

One of the most iconic Italian regions for wine, scenery, and history, Tuscany is the world's most important outpost for the Sangiovese grape. Ranging in style from fruity and simple to complex and age-worthy. Sangiovese is the backbone variety in Tuscany. While it is best known as the chief component of Chianti, it reaches the height of its power and intensity in the complex, long-lived Brunello di Montalcino.

Red cherry extract, violet, vanilla, orange zest and sweet baking spices all burst from the glass of this hearty Rosso. The juicy fruit is supported by supple tannins



The grapes are sourced primarily from three Santa Barbara regions on the vanguard: Ballard Canyon, Sta. Rita Hills and Santa Maria Valley....The Paring Red and Paring Sauvignon Blanc wines explore different blending opportunities where experimentations with site and varieties are key!

Cabernet Sauvignon: 50%, Merlot: 20%, Cabernet Franc: 20%, Petit Verdot: 10%. A fascinating nose mixing lifted black fruit, savory green herbs, dark notes of grilled bread, espresso and anise. Fills the palate with bright red fruit and black plum.

Venica sits in a really beautiful location... between the gentle hills of the Collio with the Julian Pre-Alps in the background and at only a short distance from the border with Slovenia.

The natural copper-color extracted with maceration is the signature of this wine and its richness with reminiscent of pear Williams, banana, and Acacia flowers wrapped in a slight scent of fresh apricot. Intriguing taste with pleasant flavors of pear syrup and quince peels.
