I know the school children and staff are going to be so excited! Congratulations to Lakeridge Baptist in Lubbock for receiving the President's Award for having donated the most money to the project.

The new project is the BMA Bible Institute of Zambia. Missionary Mickeal Quillman is planning to build a place for locals to attend discipleship, multiplication, pastoral, and church leadership training. Be watching for more information on the project and prayerfully consider giving to this worthy cause. The goal is \$80,000.


