## **THEMES AND PROMISES**

### **Week 1 (14th Sunday in Ordinary Time)**

Theme: We are proclaimers and witnesses of God's Kingdom when we spread the Gospel of Christ to everyone.

Promise: "...your heart shall rejoice...the Lord's power shall be known to his servants." (Is 66:14)

### **Week 2 (15th Sunday in Ordinary Time)**

Theme: We are proclaimers and witnesses of God's Kingdom when we show compassion and kindness to the helpless.

Promise: "The Lord hears the poor, and his own who are in bonds, he spurns not." (Ps. 69:34)

### **Week 3 (16th Sunday in Ordinary Time)**

Theme: We are proclaimers and witnesses of God's Kingdom when we listen to Jesus and act on His teachings.

Promise: "It is Christ in you, the hope for glory." (Col 1:27b)

### **Week 4 (17th Sunday in Ordinary Time)**

Theme: We are proclaimers and witnesses of God's Kingdom when we persevere in prayer and receive the gifts of the Spirit.

Promise: "For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." (Lk 11:10)
