

Rockford Town Regular Council Meeting May 6, 2020 7:00pm

Mayor Pro-Tem Harnois called the regular meeting to order at 7:04pm. Because of the COVID19, and the social distancing instructions, the meeting was conducted via Zoom videoconference.

Roll call took place. Those present were Councilmembers Clint Stevenson, Micki Harnois, Tim Fricke and William Benson. Deputy Clerk Jennie Hagen and Public Works Director Dave Thompson were also in attendance.
