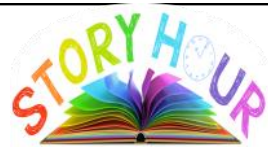

Greg Brenton, of South Coast Story Slams, will be our guest host for the evening.



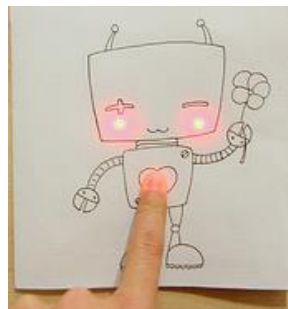
