#### GRACE AND WORSHIP

<sup>21</sup> But now, apart from the law, the righteousness of God has been disclosed and is attested by the Law and the Prophets, <sup>22</sup> the righteousness of God through the faith of Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction, <sup>23</sup> since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; <sup>24</sup> they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, Romans 3:21-24

This past Sunday, we celebrated Reformation Sunday together as a congregation, and what a joyful celebration it was! I am especially delighted to announce that two new students were confirmed into our faith family at Mt. Hermon: Aaron Head and Dylan Whitaker. We welcome them warmly to this community of faith. Their confirmation reminds us of the ongoing work of the Holy Spirit in calling people to faith and strengthening them in their walk with Christ.

Many Christian denominations believe in grace, and rightly so—it is central to our faith. However, the understanding of grace differs among Christians. While some denominations believe that grace is primarily shared through their sacraments or earned through religious practices, Lutherans understand grace to be God's love freely given. There is nothing we can do to earn more grace, and there is nothing we can do to earn less. It is a gift from God, pure and simple.

The Apostle Paul writes in his letter to the Romans that we are justified by grace as a gift. Hear that? We are all sinners! We all fall short of the glory of God. But then—and here is the good news that changes everything—because of Jesus, we are made right with God through the blood of Jesus as a gift! Not because we deserved it. Not because we worked hard enough. But simply because God loves us and chose to give us this incredible gift.

Many of you are very good at sending thank you notes. I know because I have received some from you, and they always brighten my day. When someone gives you a gift—especially a meaningful, generous gift—the natural response is gratitude. Now, imagine receiving a gift so enormous, so valuable, so life-changing that you could never possibly repay it. Perhaps you might understand that worship is our response to a gift that we could never be able to repay.

Worship is the highest form of praise that we offer to God. That's why we worship! We don't worship to earn God's favor or to check it off a list. We worship to continue the thank you and praise to the God who gave us everything that we have. Our very lives, our families, our faith, our salvation—all of it is gift. And so we gather week after week, not out of obligation, but out of joy and thanksgiving.




