#### **TODDLER & ME** — 45 minutes

Ages 18-35 months Tuesday 4:30-5:15 p.m. Kelsey Daubert

This is the perfect introduction to movement and dance for your child. In this class, you and your child will learn to love dance together. Students and adults should wear comfortable clothes and bare feet or ballet shoes.

#### **CREATIVE MOVEMENT**—45 minutes

Ages 3-4 Tuesday 4:30-5:15 p.m. Kelly Rice

A Creative Movement program for 3 and 4 year olds that offers a new experience for the young child in learning body awareness, self-assurance, self-esteem, coordination, flexibility, and more! The program offers the young child a chance to "perform" and prepare for more structured classes in the future. Students can wear bare feet or ballet shoes.

#### BALLET & TAP COMBO CLASS—1 Hour

This class includes 1/2 hour of ballet and 1/2 hour of tap.

#### FANTASY DANCE CLASS - 1 1/2 Hour

Ages 5-8 Tuesday, June 27 5:00-6:30 pm Kelly, Kelsey & Dayna Ages 5-8 Tuesday, August 29 5:00-6:30 pm Kelly, Kelsey & Dayna

This class includes 1/2 hour of ballet, 1/2 hour of tap, and 1/2 hour of jazz.

#### BALLET, TAP & JAZZ COMBO CLASS—11/2 Hours

Ages 9-12 Wednesday 5:30-7:00 p.m. Dayna Eichenser

This class includes 1/2 hour of ballet, 1/2 hour of tap, and 1/2 hour of jazz. This is a great class for both beginners and dancers who want to continue working on their technique throughout the summer. During the regular dance season (September-June) Ballet for this age group is one hour, jazz is 30 minutes and tap is 30 minutes.

#### HIP HOP - 1 hour

Ages 9-12 Wednesday 4:30-5:30 pm Nicole DeBiase Students should wear comfortable clothes and clean sneakers.

#### **COLLABORATIVE CHOREOGRAPHY – 1 hour**

Ages 11-18 Wednesday 5:30-6:30 pm Erin Hill

Make your own dance! Students will explore the dance elements such as space, level, focus, and form through exploratory and improvisational exercises. Then, through group collaboration with instructor supervision, the class will create their own dances.

#### **MUSICAL THEATER DANCE** – 1 hour

Intermediate/Advanced Level (Ages 11-18) Wednesday 6:30-7:30 pm Nicole DeBiase & Erin Hill

These classes are for students who want to prepare for their upcoming school musical, or for people who just love Musical Theater. Each week covers a different style of dance through a different musical. Some weeks will be original Broadway choreography and other will be inspired by Broadway choreography. Students should wear jazz shoes for this class. No singing required. Tap week(s) to be announced.

#### POINTE CONDITIONING & STRENGTHENING—1 Hour

Ages 11-18 Tuesday 6:30-7:30 pm

Cheryl Hill

This class is for experienced ballet students ages 11-18 who have been taking Ballet at an Intermediate level for at least two years, and who are interested in preparing for Pointe classes in the Fall. It is also for Intermediate and Advanced Pointe dancers who would like to strengthen their pointe technique. Only current Pointe students may wear pointe shoes in this class. Dancers who are not experienced with pointe shoes should wear ballet shoes. In order to take Pointe, the following criteria must be met: 1. Have progressed to the Intermediate level of Ballet. Understand that you must take a Ballet class plus the additional Pointe class during the regular dance season. Understand that Ballet and Pointe classes cannot be scheduled on the same day. 3. Attend all classes with a serious attitude. If you are not sure if you are eligible for pointe classes, contact Nicole.

#### CONTEMPORARY & LYRICAL—1 hour

Ages 13-18 Wednesday 7:30-8:30 pm Natalie Ruggiero

Contemporary dance is a style of expressive dance that combines elements of several dance genres including modern, jazz, lyrical and classical ballet. Contemporary dancers strive to connect the mind and the body through fluid dance movements. Lyrical is a fluid and graceful style of jazz that incorporates ballet and modern techniques.

#### INT/ADVANCED BALLET TECHNIQUE—1 hour

Ages 13-18 Tuesday 7:30-8:30 p.m. Levian Mondville

This ballet class is for teen dancers with experience and who want to focus on ballet technique.

#### INT/ADVANCED TURNS. LEAPS AND PROGRESSIONS—1 hour

Ages 13-18 Wednesday 6:30-7:30 pm Erin Hill / Natalie Ruggiero

Take your turns, leaps and progressions to the next level. Jazz and Ballet experience necessary for this class. Dancers should wear ballet and/or jazz shoes.

#### TEEN & ADULT BALLET— 1 hour

Age: 13 - Adult Tuesday 7:30-8:30 pm Kelsey Daubert

This is a class for beginner students who would like to learn ballet basics and intermediate students who would like to improve their ballet technique.

#### TEEN & ADULT TAP— 1 hour

Age: 13 - Adult Tuesday 6:30-7:30 pm Kelsey Daubert

This is a class for beginner students who would like to learn tap basics and intermediate students who would like to improve their basic tap skills and technique.
