# **Kittitas County Prehospital EMS Protocols**

SUBJECT: SODIUM BICARBONATE

### **ACTION:**

Combines with excessive acids to form a weak volatile acid, increases pH.

### **INDICATIONS:**

Hyperkalemia, tricyclic anti-depressant overdose, presence of Crush Injury Syndrome

#### **CONTRAINDICATIONS:**

Alkalotic states.

### **PRECAUTIONS:**

Correct dosage is essential to avoid overcompensation of pH, can deactivate catecholamines, can precipitate with calcium.

### **SIDE EFFECTS:**

Alkalosis

### DOSAGE:

<u>1 mEq/kg initially followed by 0.5 mEq/kg every 10 minutes</u> until blood gas studies are available

## **ROUTE:**

IV / IO

### **PEDIATRIC DOSE:**

Same as above.
