**“ANTLERS & TOP HATS & TIARAS” WINE, ALE & SPIRIT STROLL**  
**SAT., OCT. 19, 2019: FESTIVAL 9AM-4PM AND WINE/BEER/SPIRIT STROLL 4-7PM**

Participating Wineries & Breweries are required to provide:

- **TABC Festival Permit by October 10, 2019**
- **Liability Insurance Certificate**
- Signage and decor for your table
- Corkscrews and wine tools
- Cooler and ice for keeping wine cool during festival time
- Be prepared to serve up to 350+ wine/beer tastings for stroll participants, 4-7pm
- Vendor fee of \$100 check/money order/credit card due with application to reserve vendor space
- Recommend *two people* to staff your table and to serve tastings (you may want to have one server designated for VIP ticket holders)
- Provide name of up to 4 wines that you will be pouring for tastings
- Promotional material to be displayed only on table
- You will be able to sell by the glass and bottle to the public (festival attendees) 9AM-4PM
- **Wine, Ale & Spirit Stroll** attendees may purchase what they want during the event, 4-7PM. Pricing and availability is at the winery/vineyard discretion.
- Monitor proper age and consumption
- Each winery/brewery will serve 2 tasting per participant and mark off tasting card. (Participants are only allowed 2 tastings per winery)
- *Optional: Wine/Beer/Gift to Calvert Main Street Preservation for event prize drawing to participants who visit all wineries/ breweries and turn in card \*\*\**
- **MUST BE SET UP BY 8AM if participating in all-day festival (or by 3PM if only participating in wine/ale/spirit stroll, 4-7PM)**
- **BREAKDOWN 7:15PM.**

Calvert Main Street Preservation will provide:

- (1) 6' table with draped cloth (vendor may provide their own or additional set up)
- 10X10' area (inside covered wine/beer hall); vendor area varies at each participating business location
- Washing stations with bucket and spray bottle for rinsing; ice available
- Four one ounce pour spouts issued to each winery. (Please return spouts at the end of the event)
- A sign will be placed at your table with your winery/ brewery name
- Punch tool to mark off tastings on Tasting Card
- 2 heavy duty trash bags (Wineries/Breweries cannot leave any trash); bagged trash will be picked up by event personnel after the event
- Winery Logo promotion on social media and website
- Winery/ Brewery Logo printed on **Wine, Ale & Spirit** bag
- Secured Wifi with password for vendors only
- **\*\*\*E-Mail list of Wine, Ale & Spirit participants for post event prize drawings to vendors who provide a gift donation**

**Attendees will receive:**

**General Admission**

- Collectable wine glass for 2 tastings per winery/ brewery, wine glass lanyard, winery/ brewery tasting card, “Wine, Ale & Spirit” shopping bag, eligible prize drawing by visiting all wine/ beer vendors and turning in tasting card at the end of the event
- *Additional single wine tastings are at the discretion and cost of the winery/ brewery*

**VIP Tickets – All of the above plus+**

- VIP designated wine glass lanyard, VIP check-in line, VIP tasting line at each winery/ brewery location, access to VIP seating in wine/ beergarten near the south stage and VIP priority visit with one of the Hunters Moon **Wine, Ale and “Spirits”** (fortune teller, psychic, palm reader or tarot card reader)

I understand that I am choosing to participate in event at my own risk and hereby release Calvert Main Street Preservation, Robertson County, City of Calvert and the “**Antlers, Top Hats & Tiaras**” committee/organizers from any liability arising from the event or the use of Main Street business properties and/or City premises for those purposes. I have read and understand the rules that have been established by Calvert Main Street Preservation’s “**Antlers, Top Hats & Tiaras**” committee and I further agree to abide by the rules and regulations as enumerated herein and as maybe set forth in the future. Furthermore, I hereby release and forever discharge the Calvert Main Street Preservation, Robertson County or City of Calvert from any responsibility or liability for loss, claims, damages, theft, injury, death or accident. In the event that Winery/Vineyard damage due to negligence on his/her part the Winery/Vineyard will be responsible for those damages. I understand that there are no refunds or rain dates once my deposit/payment has been processed. It is further agreed that this applicant shall maintain his/her space, wine/beer products, merchandise, activities and business practices in compliance with the laws of the State of Texas and the City Ordinances of Calvert and Robertson County. Applicant understands that any violation of or non-compliance with same may result in immediate expulsion of Applicant and his/her exhibit from the Festival. In addition Applicant understands that the signed application is a binding contract between them and **Hunters Moon Main Street Festival** and “**Antlers, Top Hats & Tiaras**” “organized by Calvert Main Street Preservation.

Enclosed in this packet is an application form and winery/brewery vendor requirements. Winery & Brewery vendor booth spaces are located at the **Wine & Biergarten (702 S. Main/Covered 4,000sf)** and various participating **Main Street businesses** that are marked on the event map. Winery/Brewery vendor booth rates to participate as an all-day festival Winery/Brewery in the **Wine & Beiergarten or at a participating businesses on Main Street** is \$100/per booth space. **To participate in the Wine, Ale & Spirit stroll only, 4-7pm, booth spaces are \$50.** Booth assignments will be made at the discretion of the Hunters Moon Main Street “Antlers, Top Hats & Tiaras” Wine, Ale & Spirits committee. **Booth locations will be assigned in order of receipt of applications. The committee will make every effort to honor location preferences for those wineries and breweries who return their applications early.**

**FEE: Booth fees must accompany your application. If the bank returns your check, you will be charged an additional \$30.00 return check and handling fee.**

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### WINERY/BREWERY VENDOR EVENT RULES

*Please help us to maintain the integrity of this event by applying these rules.*

1. A completed and signed application with a check/money order/credit card to **Calvert Main Street Preservation** for the vendor booth fee. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry on basis of noncompliance with TABC and/or Texas State Health Laws.
2. A confirmed reservation or deposited fee from **the Hunters Moon – Main Street Moon-Festival** is a commitment to show. No refunds will be made for cancellation or removal for cause. **All-Day Festival Winery/Brewery vendors** are able to sell Saturday, October 19, 2019; 9AM to 4PM to the *public* and 4-7 PM, during the Stroll to participants wearing with wine glass lanyard. Wineries/Breweries participating in the stroll only, are able to sell from 4-7PM to participants wearing the wine glass lanyard.
3. During **the Antlers, Top Hats & Tiaras Wine, Ale & Spirit Stroll**, 4-7 PM, Winery/Brewery vendors will provide two 1 ounce tastings to stroll participants and punch the tasting card.
4. *For public safety, vendors may not leave until the Wine, Ale & Spirit Stroll ends (breakdown begins at 7:15PM) and exit the back of the festival grounds to not interfere with any Wine, Ale & Spirit Stroll participants still on Main Street.*
5. **No Bottled Water may be sold from any vendors (these are exclusive of another class of concession.) No food, specialty food/drinks or soft drinks may be sold from a winery/brewery vendor (these are exclusive to food truck/food vendors.)** The Standards Committee shall have the right to request the removal of food or drink, which violates any of the rules of the Hunters Moon Main Street Moon-Fest food/beverage Concessions or **Antlers, Top Hats & Tiaras Wine, Ale & Spirit Stroll**.
6. All-Day Festival Winery/Brewery Booth sizes are approximately 10' x 10'. Winery/Brewery vendors will provide their own tools (cork screws, etc.) Set up time is after 6PM on Friday, Oct. 18, 2019 until 8 AM. Saturday, October 19, 2019. This is important because the festival grounds will be very busy by 8AM., Saturday morning. Note: there is no electricity available but may be negotiated based on assigned location with individual business owners.
7. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE AFTER CONFIRMATION OF APPLICATION OR DEPOSITED FEE.** Booths not occupied by 9AM on Saturday will be reassigned.
8. **NO FIREWORKS** of any kind are allowed on the festival grounds.
9. Vehicles are not allowed in the area after set up. Please move to a parking lot before 8AM. There are designated parking lots for vendors.
10. Sales tax collection and payment will be the vendor's responsibility. Please include Sales Tax permit number on your entry application and follow up with TABC festival permit upon availability.
11. Four one ounce pour spouts will be issued to each winery; breweries will need use measurements based on method of pouring for tastings.
12. **ALL PROVIDED EVENT GOODS (6' TABLE, TABLE CLOTH, POUR SPOUTS, SIGNS, PUNCH TOOL, ETC.) MUST REMAIN AT VENDOR SPOT AFTER THE EVENT. ALL TRASH MUST BE BAGGED AND EVENT PERSONNEL WILL PICK UP.**
13. Please have additional waste receptacles available with plastic bag liners. Empty frequently – full trash bags may be deposited in dumpsters located on various locations. This is for sanitations and a clean appearance for the Festival. **COMPLIANCE WILL BE NOTED.**
14. A signed **HOLD HARMLESS AND IDEMNITY AGREEMENT** is required with application.
15. In addition, Wineries/Breweries Requirements, Calvert Main Street Preservation Agreement and Attendee Benefits (page 1)
16. **OPTIONAL: Many festival-goers and participants will be wearing headdress and fashions adorned with antlers, top hats & tiaras for the Hunters Moon festival theme; you are encouraged to dress or decorate with the festival theme in mind.**

*The Health Department or Texas Comptroller MAY come visit you at one time or another during the event. Be Ready...*


