

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance No.: O- 2016-18**

**AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE POSITION OF PUBLIC SAFETY  
AND SERVICE DIRECTOR, REPEALING ORDINANC NO. O-2013-62,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Village Council has determined that the duties performed by the Public Safety and Service Director are no longer necessary for the safe and efficient operation of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the duty of Council to be fiscally responsible with the citizen's tax dollars and to provide necessary services to the Village and all of its agencies and departments; and

**WHEREAS**, Village Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to eliminate the position of Public Safety and Service Director;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I.** That the position of Public Safety and Service Director shall be eliminated as the duties of the position are no longer necessary for the safe and efficient operation of the Village.

**SECTION II.** That Ordinance No. O-2013-62, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION III.** Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION IV.** This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is the immediate need to continue providing cost effective and professional engineering, planning and zoning services to the Village and its residents. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Mr. Campbell moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
