

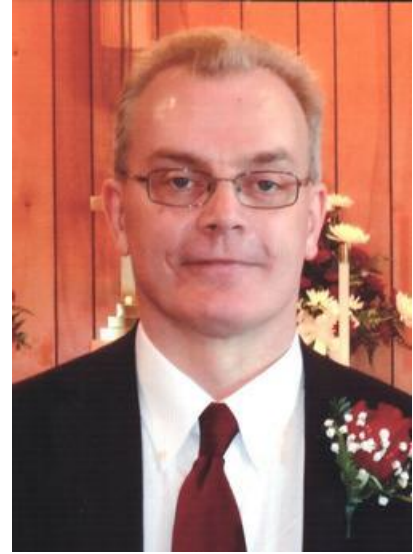
David P Schafer
