A MESSAGE FROM OUR COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR

DeColores to all my brothers and sisters in the Central Alabama Emmaus Community. As most of you know by now, in March, Aleta Fountain found it necessary to step down as Community Lay Director and resign from the Emmaus Board of Directors. Aleta asked me if I would allow her to place my name in nomination to replace her as Community Lay Director; and, after much prayer, I agreed. At the March 15th board meeting the board did me the great honor of electing me to fill out the remainder of Aleta's term as Community Lay Director.

I do not take this responsibility lightly. Having worked in this ministry for the past five years, I've gotten to meet and work with many of you, and I've never met an Emmaus brother or sister that I didn't immediately come to love and respect. This ministry has meant the world to me and to so many others; it literally changes lives. I know most, if not all, of you have experienced the same thing.

Between now and January of 2010 when my term ends, I hope to be God's instrument in carrying on and further strengthening this wonderful ministry. Some of the challenges I see before us this year are updating our bylaws (adopted in 1993 and last amended in 1997), establishing committees to assist the Board of Directors work-area representatives in managing such activities as updating the work-area manuals and helping find chairpersons and workers for each walk, supporting and strengthening our Chrysalis/Journey ministry, improving our training for and support of pilgrim sponsors, and strengthening our group reunion activities. It is also my goal to meet quarterly with the Cluster Lay Directors to get their input and ideas for how we can improve the ministry.

Finally, I solicit your input and ideas as well. If you have an idea for how we can make our ministry even better or if you have a question about anything the board is doing, I hope you won't hesitate to call or email me.

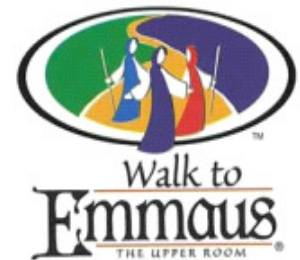

His new bride JoAnn is a deeply committed Christian lady of Roman Catholic background, who also just happens to have experienced a Walk to Emmaus!

I share this with you in order to say that after spending seventeen Walks/Chrysalis Flights in the Conference Room (including my original Walk #44) I now have an unshakeable belief that the heartbeat of the Emmaus experience begins in the prayers of the members of the Emmaus Community. I will be asking each member of the Walk 119 team to join me in praying daily for each Pilgrim between now and May 13--and I will be thanking God for those who sign up for the 72-hour Prayer Vigil.

(Repeat from Steve Kopp on how to serve in the Conference Room)

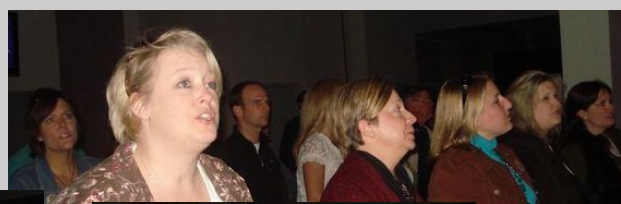
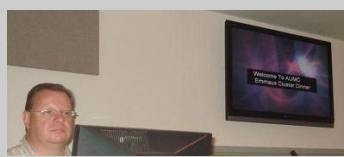
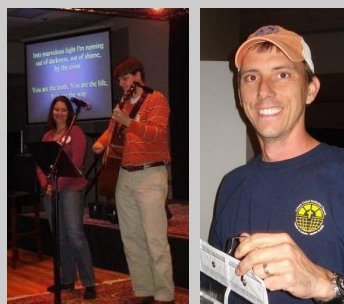
I would like to share a few insights on the Team Selection process for all who are new to the Emmaus community, and a reminder for all of us who have been serving. The question comes up all the time, how do I get asked to be in the conference room? There are a few basic rules, and I will share those in a minute. All you have to do is come to camp and serve. Bring your Christian heart, your Agape smile, your spirit of cooperation and charity, and trust me, the upcoming lay directors will notice and they will want you to be on the team that God has given them.

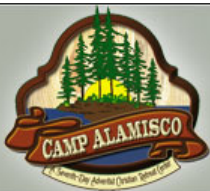
But there are a few minimum requirements to be eligible to serve. **First, you are not eligible until a year has passed since your original walk. This gives you time to reflect on your walk, and gives you plenty of time to serve in the background at Emmaus. You must have served at least 4 times in the background, and chair at least one work area.** One of the most important jobs of the chair is to make sure that all who help receive credit for serving. Please remember to turn in your service sheets, making sure that the names can be read, and that the walk numbers of each worker is listed. It is the only way that the chair of the team selection committee can determine for sure who served. There are many of you with the same name, so help yourself and the team selection chair to give you credit. Just a reminder, **there is a difference in chairing and co-chairing. The purpose of co-chairing is a learning position, where you expect to chair the work area in the near future, and co-chairing does not count as chairing a work area. One more thing, once you have qualified and have served on a team, you are still expected and required to work in the background. You must serve at least once every three years.** So if you wonder why you haven't been called, reflect on your service.

You have served our Lord with grace and compassion, and the Lord has blessed each and every walk as the "Best-one-Ever".
