

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
ORDINANCE O-2017-41**

**AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S PROBATIONARY APPOINTMENT
OF JOHN HYDER AS PART-TIME ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR FOR
AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Amelia Village has a vacancy for an Administrative Coordinator, and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Mayor, Council desires to appoint John Hyder to fill the vacancy as Administrative Coordinator for Amelia Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Council of Amelia Village ("Village Council") does hereby confirm the Mayor's probationary appointment of John Hyder, as Administrative Coordinator for Amelia Village, beginning December 25, 2017.

SECTION II. John Hyder shall serve a probationary period of one year, at such time the Mayor, with the concurrence of Village Council, shall remove him from the position or upon successful completion of the probationary period appoint him to serve as Administrative Coordinator for Amelia Village on an at-will employment basis. Basis contingent on a background check.

SECTION III. Mr. Hyder's salary shall be set at an amount not to exceed \$16,900.00 yearly beginning the first pay period of 2018 and paid out once a month with Council's and the Mayor's pay.

SECTION IV. Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the position of Administrative Coordinator will be vacant at the first of the year. This appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary administrative services to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MR. MELLENDEZ seconded the motion.
