Johnson Applied Solutions LLC (JAS) was awarded year two contract extension for the execution of the Texas Partners in Policymaking Program. Texas Partners is under contract management with the Texas Education Agency (TEA) and project oversight by the Texas Council for Developmental Disabilities (TCDD). The JAS / Texas Partners Project Training Team 2017-2018 workshop sessions will start the first of 8 sessions on August 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in Austin Texas.
