

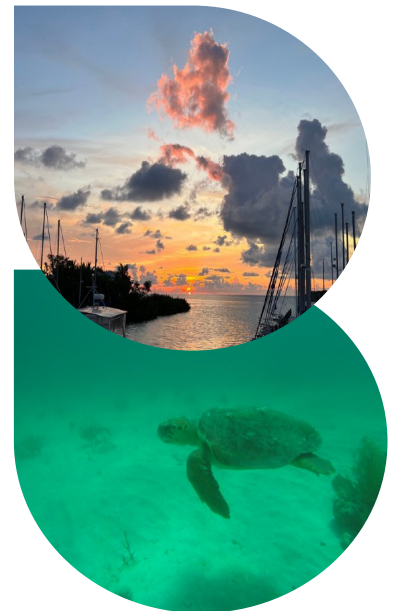


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WILLISTOWN TROOP 78

2027 High Adventure – Sea Base

Join Troop 78 for an unforgettable trip to Scouting America's high adventure Sea Base full of ocean exploration and good scouting fun!!

Register today so you don't miss the boat

Dates:

- **Primary: March 20-28, 2027** (Over "typical" spring break, some school districts have not yet released their 2026-27 school calendar but based on research, this should support most participation). We may choose to leave on March 19, depending on arrival date requirements; to be confirmed over the summer of 2026.
- **Backup: July 17-25, 2027** (If we are unable to get spring break and/or if there isn't enough scouts that can join once school calendars are released, we will move to the backup dates). We may choose to leave on July 16, depending on arrival date requirements; to be confirmed over the summer of 2026.

Sea Base Adventures: If sufficient crew members, you will have the choice of **three** Sea Base adventures.

- **Adventure A: SCUBA Adventure (Crew size of 6-8)**
 - The Florida Keys are home to the only coral barrier reef in North America. From Sea Base's fleet of custom-built Newton Dive Specials, you will explore coral reefs, discover wrecks, underwater rock formations, and scuba dive. During this adventure (weather permitting) you will make as many as 11 dives, including a night dive. Accommodations are bunks at Sea Base. **You must be a certified PADI Open Water Diver to participate.**
- **Adventure B: SCUBA Live Aboard (Crew size of 4-6 or 10-12)**
 - Scuba combined with a live-aboard experience creates one incredible adventure, the same SCUBA experience as Adventure A, but you live on a boat! When you are not diving, there will be opportunities for fishing and cruising the Florida Keys. **You must be a certified PADI Open Water Diver to participate.**
- **Adventure C: US Virgin Island / St. Thomas Sailing (Crew size of 10-12)**
 - Experience the allure of the U.S. Virgin Islands, offering some of the best sailing in the world. Sail a 40-foot vessel with an experienced captain as you circumnavigate the crystal blue waters surrounding the island of St. John. In addition to sailing, your unit will snorkel pristine coral reefs, hike in Virgin Islands National Park, swim ashore to incredible beaches, and more!

Cost (assumes maximum crew size):

- **\$2,400 (estimate)**, includes flights, meals and gear; final number may change based on crew size
- **If not diver certified**, an additional projected \$700 per person for PADI Open Water Diver Certification

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Requirements:

- 1st Class Scout Rank
- +13 years or older by departure date
- Certified PADI Open Water Diver (For any scuba adventure A or B)
- Must have attended 1 week of Summer Camp in 2026
- Registered & active in the troop (50% min participation)
- Additional Sea Base Requirements
 - Participants must be in good health evidenced by the Scouting America Annual Health and Medical Record (All sections (A, B and C) no other form is acceptable) filled out and signed by their doctor after August 1st, 2026
 - Every participant should meet Scouting America Height and Weight Guidelines. Due to restrictions on safety and rescue equipment, no persons weighing more than 295lbs. are allowed to participate, regardless of height.
 - Every participant must be classified as a Scouting America Swimmer; evidenced by a signed [unit swim classification record](#) completed August 1st, 2026. This will be coordinated by your crew leader
 - All participants must know and use the Scout Oath and Law as their guide to appropriate behavior at Sea Base

- Note:** final amount may adjust based on crew size

Additional Crew meetings will be held throughout 2026 to prepare for this trip, organize PADI dive certifications for those in need and closer to the departure date pack for the trip. Once the Crew roster is established, each crew member will be assigned roles for the trip.
