The Palmetto Club Clubhouse Rules (Revised)

1. A member of the club must be in attendance at all outside functions.

2. No person shall bring into the clubhouse food or drinks that can be supplied by the kitchen without the permission of the Executive Board.

3. All property not belonging to the Palmetto Club must be removed from the clubhouse within twenty-four (24) hours of the group's event. Under no circumstances are furnishings or equipment to be removed from the clubhouse without prior approval of the House Chairman.

4. Furniture, piano, floral pieces and pictures shall not be rearranged. Exceptions must be approved by the House Chairman.

- 5. The organ must never be moved or played without permission.
- 6. The clubhouse is a No Smoking Building.

7. No nails, tape or decorations may be attached to walls, curtains, silk trees, overhead lights or fans, and no pictures or furniture removed.

8. All card parties will terminate by 3:00 PM.

9. Reservations must be made no later than 9:00 AM Monday prior to the event. Meals must be paid for unless canceled forty-eight (48) hours in advance.

- 10. The club shall not be responsible for articles left in the clubhouse.
- 11. All functions shall end by 2:00 PM the day before any special fund raiser.
- 12. No alcohol is permitted to be brought into or taken out of the clubhouse.
- 13. Clubhouse shall not to be entered via kitchen.
- 14. No outside organization shall be permitted to make any type of solicitation nor sell tickets at any Palmetto Club function without prior permission of the President.
- 15. One Day Guest Membership: The club may grant a one-day Guest Membership to a person(s) attending a function sponsored and attended by a club member(s). The guest is entitled to use only those club facilities and services directly related to the sponsored function
- 16. Club activities shall take precedence over any outside activity.
- 17. The courtesy of the club is extended at all times to the President.
- 18. Changes of address of members shall be sent to the Financial Secretary.
- 19. The membership list is not to be given to anyone for advertising purposes.
- 20. Each member is given one copy of the Yearbook. Extra copies may be purchased for \$6.00.
