Tournament Wrap-Up

The highly anticipated January 2026 2-Man Best Ball Tournament was a great success, with 112 golfers (56 teams) originally registered to play. After one team cancellation, we finished the day with 110 players competing.



Unfortunately, a team competing in A Flight recorded their Closest-to-the-Pin on the B Flight marker. While this has occurred in the past, doing so unfortunately invalidates the Closest-to-the-Pin for the entire flight. We sincerely apologize to our B Flight players for the inconvenience.



As a reminder to all members, please take a moment to read and follow the tournament rules—they are in place for a reason. Be sure to double- and triple-check which flight you are playing in, as it is clearly noted on your scorecard. Playing in a certain flight regularly does not automatically place you in that same flight for team events.

A friendly reminder to members who register and pay via Zelle: please be sure to check in at the registration table on tournament day. This helps us maintain an accurate player count when settling payments with the course.

The tournament paid out a total of **\$5,558** to **35 teams (70 members)**. Our **50/50 winners** were **Ralph Aldrete, Mark Comparone, and Pat Bates**, each taking home **\$130**. The **free round of golf** was won by **Bruce Davis**. Congratulations to all of our winners and thank you to everyone who participated.

Upcoming Tournament – February 7

Next month's tournament will take place on **February 7** and will be the **President's Cup Individual Low Net Qualifier**. The top **16 players in each flight** will advance to compete in Match

Play. For complete details, please visit the website under **Rules – President's Cup Match Play**.

Online registration will be opening soon in **Golf Genius**, and a full field is expected.

This is an individual event, and you must register yourself!

When signups open, please follow these steps:

1. Navigate through the signup confirmation by selecting **Playing or Not Playing**.
2. If needed, you may **send a message to the manager** with any special requests.
3. Click **Send** to complete your registration.

Once confirmed, player names will populate on the Golf Genius tee sheet. Registered players should also receive an automated Golf Genius confirmation email.

Please note that one of the biggest challenges we face is managing special requests. While we do our best, some requests cannot be accommodated for various reasons. Your understanding is greatly appreciated. Tournament fields are capped, and once full, players will be placed on a waitlist. If you need assistance with the signup process, please don't hesitate to contact us.

The Golf Genius Signup Portal will close on February 3rd, or earlier if the player limit is reached. Sign up early to guarantee a spot.

We will confirm the roster of signed-up players via email on **Wednesday, February 4th** prior to the tournament, and release pairings on **Friday, February 6th**.

How to Sign Up in Golf Genius:

When signups open, please follow these steps:

1. You or your playing partner should proceed through the signup confirmation and select "Playing."
2. Click "Sign up other members," scroll, and add your partner's name.
3. If needed, send a message to the tournament manager with your team pairing and/or any special requests.
4. Click "Send". Once you and your partner are confirmed, names appear on the tee sheet roster in Golf Genius. All registered players receive an automated signup confirmation email. As always, we will monitor signups closely and reach out if there are any issues.

Important Reminders

Please connect with your partner early to confirm availability before registering. If you are signing up as a single, please note this in a message to the manager and we will do our best to pair you with another single.

Tournament size is capped, and a waitlist is used once capacity is reached. If you have any questions or need help with the signup process, don't hesitate to reach out.

Skins News

When it comes to skins games and tournaments, there are always questions that come up about the selection of tees for each flight. This is not something that we decide on a whim or without thought.



We never want members/guests playing from tees that make it difficult to even play the course. From certain tees, some members would find it difficult to play a course where they are hitting 3-woods into most of the Par 4's. From the opposite perspective, we have low-mid handicap players that believe their correct tees are from the blue stones. For tournaments, it's not easy to negotiate the middle ground in the B Flight. There are a few members typically in the B flight that hit the ball a decent length and think the tees are wrong, but the majority are definitely playing from the proper tees. So, the quandary is to put 80% of the flight on the tees where some of them cannot even reach fairways, or continue to leave those that believe they should be playing the longer course, on the white tees?

The USGA gives us a great tool to help determine what tees are appropriate and will make the game most enjoyable. Here is how the formula works. Take the distance you hit your average 5-iron and multiply that by 36. That is the length you should be playing the course and corresponding tees.

For instance, if you hit your "average" 5-iron 170-yards:

- $170 \times 36 = 6120$ yards. This is the length of course you should be playing.

In the end, if you fall into the B flight category and believe you are playing tees that are too short for your game, then your game should be able to prove it and in now time your handicap will fall and you will be on the tees you should be playing from. Playing your way from one flight to another is the best way to ensure you play the tees you should be playing.

It states in our bylaws that your rounds need to be posted on the day played but if you miss it you can back date it when you post or text me and I can put it in the next day and update your handicap.

Pro's Corner

Members thank you for another banner year that you provided for El Prado Golf Courses. We appreciate the loyalty you have shown, and we are very excited to show you what 2026 has in store for everyone. I am excited to share some great news in terms of the renovations expected for 2026. The first is fixing our main roof in the banquets and golf areas, construction is scheduled in the next week and we are excited to get this done. The next is the completion of our banquet space, we will be renovating the remaining banquet areas to consistently hold large parties, birthdays and weddings. If you have any banquet needs, please reach out to us and we can offer great discounts for our members.



In unison with our clubhouse and banquet area renovations we will be enhancing our cart paths. The need to open on days that are affected with rain is based on being able to drive golf carts on the course. We do not have cart paths that allow our golfers to play when we have water issues on the fairways, once our cart paths are connected we now can have carts on most days that we would normally have walkers only.

For those that like to practice indoors, we will soon have simulators in place when renovation is completed. I'll talk about this more when we start the project along with the introduction of our new bar and snack bar. In regard to indoor simulators, one of our members is an owner and operator of a facility in Chino. The name of the place is Smash Factor Lounge and Chace Fraser our very own member has very graciously offered that any "El Prado members now get 10 percent off at Smash Factor Lounge! Call (909) 270-3628 to book and identify yourself as an El Prado member to get your 10 percent discount".

Lastly, I don't have a rules question this month but I do have information that relates to when a player hits a hanging live wire or its tower. The rule in effect is Rule E-11 that was instituted as a local rule by our Men's Club it allows the player to re-hit when a live wire or tower is hit by their golf ball. If you picture hole # 12 on Chino Creek, the left side of the fairway has the towers that hold the live wire across the fairways of #12 and #13. If you hit the wires it will be an automatic re-hit of the shot and if you hit the tower either by having your ball fly towards the tower or your ball rolls towards the tower you are also entitled to a re-hit of your shot. I wanted to make sure this was understood just in case you face this scenario on the golf course.
