

Rockford Town Council Public Hearing
October 21, 2015 7:00 PM

Mayor Carrie Roecks called the public hearing to order at 7:00pm. The public hearing was held to discuss what project(s) are of importance and what funds should be requested of the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) in 2016.

Mr. Thompson stated that the I&I project and the well are top two priorities, he thinks the well should be our top priority.
