| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Diarrhea or vomiting.</b> The child may return when completely free from symptoms for 48 hours. Child will be sent home if they have a watery stool that cannot be contained in diaper or underpants or 3 or more soft, loose stools in a 4 hour period or 1 time vomiting. | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Pediculosis (head lice).</b> The child may return to school following a minimum of two days of treatment and no nits (eggs) are observable by staff upon return.  |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Impetigo.</b> The child may return to school after antibiotics have been administered for 24 hours, or when sores are very dry with no yellow crust, and no longer oozing (about 7-10 days), <b>with a doctor's note and absence of other symptoms.</b>                     | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Cold.</b> The child may attend school if he or she is free from fever and general malaise for 48 hours. If a child has a lingering cough (a signal of an upper respiratory infection), he or she should be seen by a physician and return will require a negative COVID test.   |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Fever.</b> Temperatures <b>above 99F (oral) or 98.4F (axillary) under the arm.</b> Child may return when free from fever for <b>48 hours without</b> the aid of fever reducing medicine.  | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Ringworm or Athlete's Foot.</b> The child may attend if the infected area is being treated for 24 hours <b>and</b> is covered.  |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>General Malaise.</b> A child who does not eat or have the energy and requires 1:1 attention does not belong at school until fully able to participate.  | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Strep Throat.</b> The child may return to school <b>after 24 hours of treatment</b> with medication <b>and</b> child has no fever for 48 hours.   |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Earache.</b> The child should be seen by a physician and return to school following a <b>minimum of 24 hours</b> of treatment and absence of other symptoms.  | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Conjunctivitis (pink-eye).</b> The child may return to school following 24 hours of treatment with prescribed medication.   |
|   | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Rash.</b> Out of care if child has fever or until a doctor determines that it is not contagious ( <b><u>must have a note from the doctor</u></b> ). In some cases, such as Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (or other illnesses which cause blisters filled with fluid), children may not return until the blisters have stopped developing and have scabbed over, regardless of doctor's note. |

*All above symptoms do not assume COVID-19 as an underlying cause. If child has 2 or more symptoms, child may **NOT** return for a minimum of 10 days (at least 3 days after symptoms have subsided but no sooner than 10 days of isolation/quarantine) **without** a negative COVID-19 test.*
