

Constellation Construction for Beginners

The constellations of Orion and The Plough are easily recognised in the night sky.

Make a model of these constellations using light-emitting diodes (or l.e.d.s) to represent the seven brightest stars in Orion or The Plough (see photos of completed kits below).

Choose the l.e.d. colour for your kit - either all blue, all green, all pink, all red or all yellow.



These kits are constructed on foam board and powered by two AA batteries. Connections are made by simply twisting wires together and crimping the joint with pliers. (A soldered joint makes a better electrical connection but soldering is not essential.)

The kits are ideal for anybody interested in starting to explore the world of electronics.
