Pack 104 is proud to offer Camperships to those Scouts who help the Pack GO!

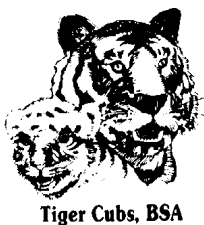
Boys who meet the requirements are eligible for Camperships of 25% of Individual Popcorn OR Nut Sales (sales made at the Show & Sell events do NOT count towards the Campership).

The money raised from the popcorn and nut sales generate about \$75 per scout to cover the costs of awards and meeting activities. Without these fundraisers these costs would have to be raised in the form of higher annual membership dues for the Pack. It is important to note that NONE of these funds are used for our Family Campouts and Pack Overnight trips that we offer. Those events are self-funded by the participants.

To be eligible for the Camperships boys must do the following:

- 1) Participate in both the Popcorn Sale and Nut Sale and sell a minimum of \$100 per sale. Whichever Sale the boys sells more product in will count towards their Campership. For example, if Johnny sells \$500 in Popcorn and \$200 in Nuts, the Campership will be based on the \$500 in Popcorn Sales ONLY. Likewise if Jimmy sells \$300 in Popcorn and \$400 in Nuts, his Campership will be based on the \$400 in Nuts he sold,
- 2) Assist with the Show & Sell fundraisers by helping for a minimum of two hours at any of the events (see the Pack Schedule or our Facebook page for dates and times).
- 3) Participate in ONE Service Project that is held outside of a Pack Activity, i.e. Stamp-Out Hunger, Spring or Fall Church Cleanups, FOP Grave Markers, Operation Christmas Child.

Campership funds may be used ONLY for District Day Camp and/or & District Resident Camp. Funds for Webelos II may be transferred to the Troop the Scout joins for use for Resident Camp only.
