The Adoption Process

Generally, within a week of receiving this application and your \$50 deposit, we will contact you for a 20-30 minute phone interview. A home visit typically is scheduled within 2-3 weeks after the phone interview. All persons who will be living in the house with the greyhound must be present for a home visit to occur. We are an all-volunteer organization, so home visits are done on weekends. During the home visit, Music City Greyhound representatives will endeavor to bring at least 2 dogs we believe will fit in your family.

Music City Greyhound takes its responsibility for placing dogs in appropriate, permanent homes seriously. If we place a dog with you, we ask that you make a commitment to your hound for life. Consider the following carefully: Yes No A greyhound's average life expectancy is 12+ years. I agree to make a lifetime commitment to my greyhound's care/wellbeing.
Yes No A hound must wear a tag collar at all times bearing his name and the owner's contact information as well as the emergency contact tag Music City Greyhound provides.
Yes No A greyhound is an indoor pet and must not be isolated in the garage, basement or left outdoors unattended.
Yes No hound should never be tied outside with a run line or other stationary tether.
Yes No a crate is typically the safest place for a greyhound when owners are away.
Yes No I understand the annual cost of owning a greyhound, including food, routine vet care and monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventative averages \$700-\$1,000. I am prepared and able to meet this minimum financial commitment as well as any and all emergency vet care and kenneling needs for the lifetime of the dog.
Yes No Hounds adopted through Music City Greyhound must be returned to this group if the owner is incapable of caring for it at any time and for any reason.
