THE ALTAR OF SACRIFICE

The purpose of this chart is to present several points of interest that gives credence to the purported crucifixion day of Jesus Christ on April 14, 32 AD. Although the date is in dispute, the date of Christ's crucifixion and death appears to be pegged to a celestial signs. The popular notion of a 33 AD date and/or Jesus being 33 years is idealistic but does not account for the BC years. This study presents a possible date association solely based on astronomical patterns taken from the patterns of the lunar and solar cycles since Sep 11, -3 BC and the Mazzaroth pattern of the cycles of the Precession of the Equinox. Contrary to popular belief, there was no Tetrad or 4 consecutive Blood Moons from 27-34 AD. There were 4 partial solar eclipses in a row in 32 AD. There is only 1 possible eclipse that occurs on a Passover, April 14, 32 AD during this time span of Jesus' age of 33 at the time of His crucifixion. Few times in history the Jewish and Western calendars synchronize. One such year was in 2014 where Passover occurred on the 14th of April as in the case in 32 AD. The full moon occurred on the 14th of April as all Passovers have to start with a full moon. What is peculiar about this full moon was that it was a Blood Moon, perhaps reminiscent of the Blood Moon that occurred the very midnight hour of the first Passover in Egypt. It also started the 2014-15 sequence of the Tetrad Blood Moons many believe were and are a harbinger.

Passover was the day that the Destroying Angel visited the land and took the First Born as was the case with Jesus Christ, as the Messiah and the 'First Born of Creation' on the altar of Calvary. The total Blood Moon occurred also in the middle of Libra, the Scales but in some ancient renditions, it was an Altar of Sacrifice.

This would collaborate the depiction of Isaac and Christ, being offered on a slab. The dual connotation though, to the Scales of Libra denote the judgment and wrath of YHVH that was placed on Christ at the Cross of Calvary that in essence was an Altar, some say perhaps the very spot in which Abraham was tried with the attempted sacrifice of Isaac.



Age of Jesus Christ at Death: 33 -3 BC, September 11 to April 14, 32 AD = 33rd Year

Passover always starts with a Full Moon, meaning no Solar Eclipses could be possible to occur. However lunar eclipses can. As to a possible date, on APRIL 14, AD 32 a Wednesday, a TOTAL LUNAR ECLIPSE was rising above the Jerusalem horizon near Midnight. This coincides the Passover event with the Destroying Angel of the night of the Exodus in Egypt. As the Cassover Meal celebration was concluding, the lunar eclipse occurred as if to 'punctuate' this time with its apex at 23:02 hours on Apr 14, 32 AD in Libra. There was a partial solar eclipse on Apr 28, 32 AD as well.

Jewish Day Count begins at Sundown.
