FYI: Hiro Diapers - there's a company which makes diapers that can be digested by plastic-eating fungi. When you change the diaper, you put a package of fungi in the diaper and throw it away. In less than 2 weeks the fungi start to grow and 'eat' diaper. This works in a typical landfill setting. Other companies are also working on this concept for other types of plastics. Mycelium is a type of fungi used to break down and degrade plastics.
