ROUND DANCE PROGRAM AT THE STATE CONVENTION FEBRUARY 15-17 2024

Round dancing at the VA State Convention February 15-17, 2024

Virginia and WASCA Round Dancers will enjoy dancing many outstanding hours with the 9 cuers at the 2024 VASARDA Convention this February at the Holiday Inn Hotel and Convention Center in VA Beach. This cueing staff will be cueing 10 hours of 2x2 [square and round] dancing and over 13 hours of phase II-IV/V round dancing. In addition there will be 7 round dance teaches presented at this Festival --

- three phase III dances -- a waltz, a two step, and a rumba-cha;
- three phase IV dances -- a jive, a tango, and a west coast swing; and
- one phase V dance -- a bolero

There are more than 230 separate dances programmed to be cued during this exciting 3 day convention. We've attached an alphabetized list of all these dances. Whether you are a new round dancer or one who has danced at various festivals and clubs over the years, we are confident you will find some great old favorites and some exciting new dances to enjoy at the 2024 VA State Convention. The dancing will be exciting at times, melodic at other times and always entertaining and energetic. Come on down to VA Beach this February and join your fellow round dancers as you move to the music you love to hear.

Beginner Round Dance classes in the area

For those who made a 2024 New Year's resolution to get more exercise and enjoy new experiences, why not make this your year to learn to dance. Several cuers are offering basic dance lessons. You could check with Calvin Crofford [hcrofford@cox.net] who is having a basic class in the Norfolk area, Amy & Ken Shotting [kashotting@aol.com] who are having lessons in Maryland on Mondays in Catonsville and Thursdays in Eldersburg and Berni and Ken Ryder [kfryder@cox.net] who are having their basic class on Sundays, from 5-6:30 PM at St Barnabas Episcopal Church in Annandale Va.

Below is a flyer on the Ryder's Sunday class. In addition to their basic class, currently reviewing rumba and cha rhythms, they hold an intermediate workshop from 6:30-7:30 PM that is currently reviewing slow two step figures. They finish a busy Sunday evening with a "class level" dance featuring dances that reflect rhythms previously taught. 
