7:00pm – Mincha / Kabbalat Shabbat

- Families who daven Mincha at 7:00pm should light candles by 7:15pm

7:54pm – Candle Lighting

8:00pm – Mincha / Kabbalat Shabbat

- The bracha "Me'ein sheva" (including Magen Avot) is omitted when davening alone; Vayichulu is said, followed by Aleinu

Shacharit – You may want to daven Shacharit at the same time that you typically do on Shabbat, or say the Amida of Shacharit at Netz, which is 5:53am

9:27am – Latest Shma

- Brich Shmei is not recited when davening alone
- Only the first paragraph of Yikum Purkan is recited when davening alone

1:37pm – Earliest Mincha

- Rabbi Baum will recite the Keil Maleh prayer for those observing yartzeit from 11–17 Av

8:11pm – Sunset (finish Mincha before sunset)

8:52pm – Ma'ariv

8:58pm – Shabbat ends
