Steele, Wheelock


Selected for Hall of Fame Induction

Steve Steele of Huntsville and the late Elizabeth Wheelock of Dothan have been named the newest inductees into the Alabama Building Industry Hall of Fame, the highest honor given by the Home Builders Association of Al-



abama. Both will be honored through a video presentation during the HBAA's Annual Convention awards gala and Hall of Fame induction ceremony on Friday, October 27, 2017 at the Henderson Beach Resort in Destin, Florida.

Steele is the owner of Steve Steele Custom Homes and a longtime member and Past President of the Huntsville/Madison County Builders Association. He has been extremely active at the state and national levels as well, serving in leadership positions on several committees. He served as HBAA President in 2011.



Wheelock served as the Executive Officer for the Home Builders Association of Dothan & the Wiregrass Area for 28 years. During her tenure, she helped grow the association from just 99 members to an all-time high of 430 mem-

bers. She was particularly instrumental in developing the association's scholarship and student loan program, which has enabled hundreds of students to pursue careers in the building industry.







The HBAA is proud to announce that it now has its own State-approved distinctive license plate! By reserving your HBAA tag today, you will be helping to promote the HBAA.

You'll also be supporting trade education, as the fees associated with the specialty plate go to the Alabama Home Builders Foundation where they will be used to expand trade education across Alabama.

How much does the HBAA license plate cost?

You'll pre-pay \$50 per license plate that you reserve through the Alabama Department of Revenue, with proceeds from that going toward the Alabama Home Builders Foundation. When you go to your local DMV to pick up your license plate(s), you'll then pay for the associated registration fees. The more HBAA license plates that are sold, the more money we are able to put toward supporting building trades education throughout Alabama!

How do I get the HBAA license plate?

Visit **www.HBAA.org** and follow the link to the precommitment form on the Alabama Department of Revenue's website. Once there, just fill out the information and follow the prompts. You'll need to have your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or current license plate number handy to complete the form.

You will receive a voucher from the State that can be applied to the purchase of the tag once the required number of precommitments is obtained.

JUST THE FACTS ABOUT A



The Home Builders Association of Alabama (HBAA) has been working hard to promote housing and pass legislation that will help you save money and improve the way you do business. Here are a few facts about how the HBAA's governmental affairs efforts are working for you:

- The HBAA is stimulating Alabama's economy through its work to pass the Alabama Home Buyer Initiative. This program will create \$300 million in economic activity.
- The HBAA's legislative efforts reduced property tax on developed lots by 50% for 2012 & 2013. That same legislation reduces the property tax on inventoried houses by 50% from now on!
- The HBAA convinced the Alabama
 Department of Public Health to create a state lead paint program in order to keep EPA out of Alabama and to lower costs for Alabama remodelers.
- The HBAA is a founding member of the Business Association Tax Coalition and the Civil Justice Reform Committee, groups that have brought about meaningful tort reform to Alabama's courts and fairness to Alabama's tax laws.
- HBAA-backed legislation eliminated the prohibition on pre-sale agreements for lot sales. This victory means commercial lenders will be more likely to provide development financing in the future.
- HBAA provisions in the new landlord tenant law increases the amount of time to return a deposit from 35 days to 60 days, reducing the administrative burden on investment property owners.

- The HBAA eliminated local government's ability to charge a business license on each unit in a multifamily development. This ensures that owners will not have to pay a fee on units that are not generating revenue.
- The HBAA took the lead in crafting Alabama's first statewide energy and building code that reflects the wishes of Alabama's builders, NOT the Federal DOE.
- HBAA legislative efforts ensure that tax appeals are heard before a tribunal instead of members of the Department of Revenue staff.
- The HBAA has partnered with Alabama Power to create the Duct and Envelope Tightness testing program, allowing HVAC contractors to conduct their own inspections and saving builders hundreds of dollars per house.
- The HBAA seeks to promote skilled trades through the use of unused HVAC and Plumbing licensure funds that currently revert to the State's general fund.
- The HBAA is working to expand incentives for wind resistant construction and retrofits statewide through potential tax credits and insurance reductions. These incentives will encourage new remodeling opportunities and consumer driven upgrades on new construction.
