TBLA’s TOLEDO BEND LUNKER PROGRAM - The 2022/23 Lunker Program concluded on Sunday, May 21. The 22/23 Lunker program had fifty-seven Lunkers that were caught and released alive back into Toledo Bend. TBLA distributed the fifty-seven replicas of these fish to the Anglers on Saturday, August 19, at the SCOA Toledo Town Facility. Highlights of this year’s Lunkers were the new Lake Record, 15.67- pound bass, which was caught by Mr. Bill Cook and by Cody Pitt’s three Lunkers that were caught in the class. A large crowd attended the event. The TBLA Lunker Program Director, Ned Goodeaux presented the replicas to the anglers. We congratulate all of them for their catches and thank them for releasing these special fish. This Lunker Class included one fifteen-pound class fish, one fourteen-pound class fish, two thirteen-pound class fish, three twelve-pound class fish, twelve eleven-pound class fish, and thirty-eight ten-pound class fish!
