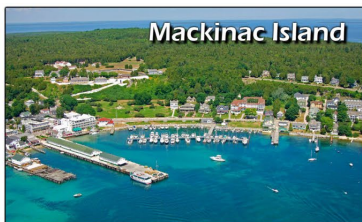

### Mackinac Island

Mackinac Island is located in Lake Huron, at the eastern end of the Straits of Mackinac next to the state's Upper Peninsula. The Straits of Mackinac and eastern UP were inhabited by the Ojibwa (Chippewa) and Potawatomi Indian Tribes in addition to the Odawa before European exploration began in the 17th century. This led to the establishment of Fort Mackinac by the British during the American Revolutionary War.

Its an Island where the automobile never replaced the horse and carriage. You have lodging properties where corporations never replaced family ownership. You have the Fort era where the British couldn't permanently replace Americans. You have Fudge Stores where box recipes never replaced our 19th Century recipes.
