

Smoking

Fox River Grove Memorial Library maintains a smoke-free environment. In accordance with the Smoke Free Illinois Act [410 ILCS 82/1 et seq.], smoking is prohibited within a minimum distance of 15 feet from entrances, exits, windows that open, and ventilation intakes that serve an enclosed area where smoking is prohibited. This Act ensures that smoke does not enter the Library through entrances, exits, open windows, or other means.

Use of chewing tobacco and the possession of spittoons are prohibited in the library.

Patrons who smoke must extinguish smoking materials prior to entering the minimum distance area.

Any patron found smoking, chewing tobacco, or possessing a spittoon must immediately leave the library and dispose of prohibited materials. If the patron persists in smoking, staff should follow the Patron Conduct policy, including summoning the police as needed.

“Smoking” shall mean inhaling of, exhaling of, burning of, or carrying of any lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, e-cigarette, marijuana, or other plant in any manner or in any form.
