BATTERY ELECTROLYTE TESTER:


A handy tool for transferring sulfuric acid from a car battery to the inside of your toolbox after determining that your battery is dead as a doornail, just as you thought.


The correct answer is B, Technician B only.

When a vacuum advance mechanism is stuck, the symptom does not change when the vacuum is disconnected. When the vacuum advance moves the distributor plate, this causes the pick-up coil wires to flex. If those wires are faulty, there could be an intermittent interruption in the output signal.
