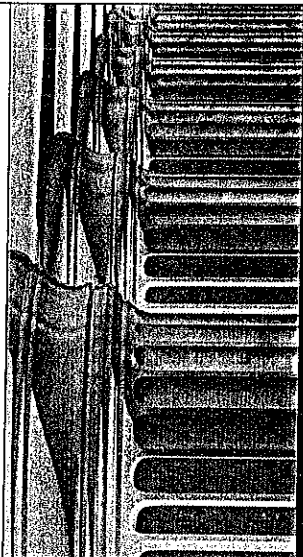

Legal problems can be puzzling when you don't know where to turn for answers. The Lawyer Referral Service can help.

What the Lawyer Referral Service can do for you

- Find a qualified lawyer who best fits your needs.
- Provide you with up to a 30-minute legal consultation with an attorney for a non-refundable \$40 administrative fee.
- Refer you to a lawyer who has professional malpractice insurance and is in good standing with both the State Bar of Arizona and the Maricopa County Bar Association.
- Provide an attorney who has legal expertise in your particular legal need.

What is the Lawyer Referral Service?

Begun in 1964, IRS is a public service of the Maricopa County Bar Association. Today, over 100 attorneys practicing in more than 30 areas of law are available through the service, and they are located throughout Maricopa County. IRS handles over 100,000 calls per year.

How do I get a lawyer referral?

1. Call (602) 257-4434.
2. Talk to an interviewer, answer a few basic questions, and pay the non-refundable administrative fee.
3. The interviewer will contact the right attorney for you and connect you to that attorney's office so you can schedule your appointment.
4. Most consultations with an attorney can be handled over the phone, but you may request to meet with the attorney at his or her office if you prefer.
5. Administrative fee (\$40) payment options: Credit card (Visa or MasterCard), money order, or cash.

IT'S THAT EASY!

You pay only the \$40 administrative fee for the initial referral and consultation. After that, it is between you and the attorney to decide whether to proceed and what the fee will be.
