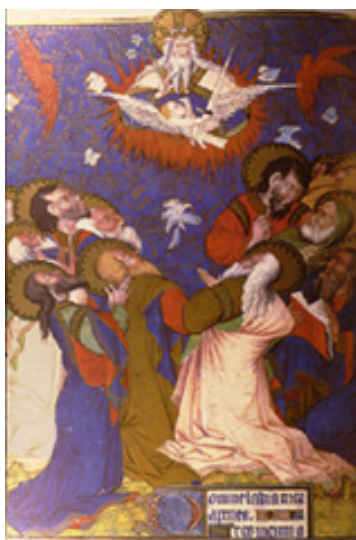

FIRST READING Acts 2:14a, 36-41



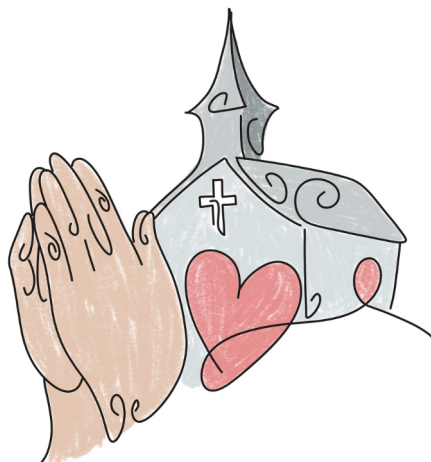

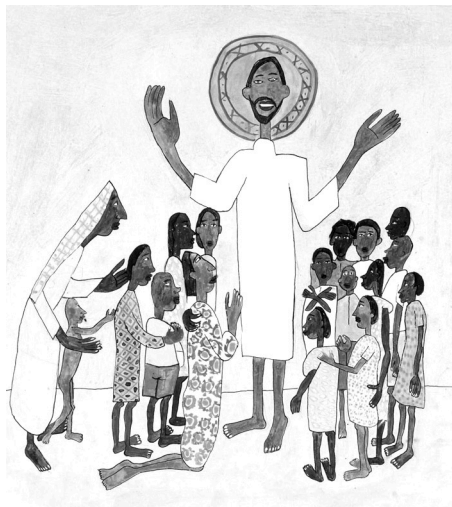
