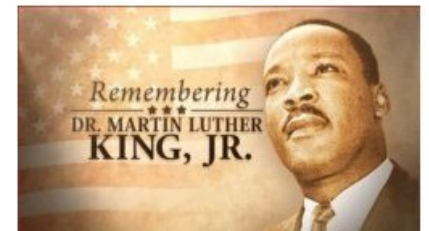

Fire on Creekside Days Before Christmas

Twelve people, including six children, were displaced by a fire on Sunday, December 19, 2021. According to Austin Fire Dept., the fire occurred in a kitchen while someone was cooking. All residents of the two-story fourplex evacuated safely. A firefighter sustained minor injuries fighting the blaze.

Fire Safety Tips:

Did you know that if a fire starts in your home **you may have as little as two minutes to escape?** During a fire, early warning from a working smoke alarm plus a fire escape plan that has been practiced regularly can save lives.

- ✓ Install smoke alarms on every level of your home, inside bedrooms, and outside sleeping areas.
- ✓ Test smoke alarms every month. If they're not working, change the batteries.
- ✓ Talk with all family members about a fire escape plan and practice the plan twice a year.
- ✓ If a fire occurs in your home, **GET OUT, STAY OUT and CALL FOR HELP.** Never go back inside for anything or anyone.



Shared Streets Program

The City of Austin is piloting a program to make residential streets that lack sidewalks safer and more comfortable for people walking and children playing. **Shelbourne Drive was identified as a candidate for this new program.** Residents along Shelbourne Drive, Brookhollow Drive, Brookhollow Cove, and Pebble Brook Drive received a postcard with information on how to participate in a neighborhood survey.
