I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to institute a process for the establishment and revision of assessments to be used to determine how well students have achieved Graduation Standards in compliance with the requirements set forth in the Rules Relating to Graduation Standards, Minnesota Rules Chapter 3501.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

NWSISD will assist its member school districts in their implementation of the Minnesota Graduation Standards. Only those NWSISD programs or activities taught by licensed teachers or advisors will be eligible to be counted towards meeting graduation requirements. NWSISD will establish a procedure, in coordination with staff from its member school districts, to develop and adopt performance assessment methods to be used in measuring student performance in eligible NWSISD programs and activities. NWSISD strives to continually enhance, through training and collegial collaboration, the capacity of its staff to identify required versus honors level performance and to score student performance against exemplars of excellent student achievement of the Graduation Standards.
