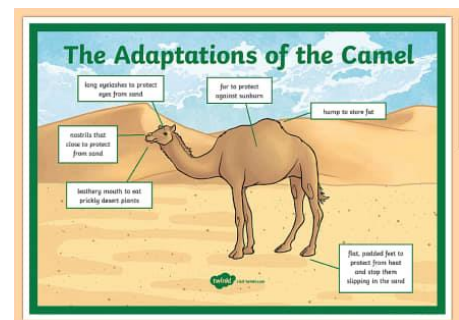


Science
