## Village of Chapin, Illinois Resolution of Adoption of the

Morgan County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, the Village of Chapin, Illinois, is subject to natural hazards including severe thunderstorms, severe winter storms, floods, tornadoes, and drought among others, that pose risks to public health and property;

WHEREAS, the Morgan County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan was updated in accordance with the regulations of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the guidance provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Chapin, Illinois, has participated in updating the Morgan County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan covering member jurisdictions of Morgan County:

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The corporate authorities of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, hereby Adopt the Morgan County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan update as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Village of Chapin, Illinois; and
- 2. The corporate authorities of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, hereby agrees, on behalf of the Village of Chapin, to participate in the annual and 5-year updates to this Plan.
