- Cement issues within community identified and will be prioritized. We are actively looking into companies and getting bids.
- Towing company still needs to be looked into.
- Need to get contact info for renters
- Watering person has been hired, Jordan will work with them to make sure things are getting done regularly and efficiently.
- We got denied from a few management companies. We are still going to try to pursue this
- Individual mailboxes are the individual homeowners responsibility
