Campground Rules for Non-seasonal Campers

Campers under age 21 must be accompanied by an adult. After 9 p.m., children under the age of 18 are to be at their assigned/registered site.

Check out Time: 11 am **Rent:** Payable in advance

Reservations: Held by depositing 1st night's fee. 24 hour cancellation notice required (1 week cancellation notice required for Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day holiday weekends and 3 night minimum payable in advance holds reservation)

Visitors must stop at office to check in before going to site. No more than 2 visitors per site and no more than one additional vehicle.

Campers must register - before occupying a site.

One unit per site - No additional equipment / tents are allowed.

Quiet time is from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. This is strictly enforced. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Do not disturb others.

Fireworks are prohibited. ABSOLUTELY **NO FIREWORKS!** **NO EXCEPTIONS!** **NO EXCUSES!**

No lifeguard on duty - swim at your own risk! No swimming after dark!

ATV/UTV's are not allowed.

Golf carts may be driven after dark if they have proper lights (no flashlights) and are driven by adults only. No kids are allowed to drive golf carts after dark. Parents! - make sure your children are driving in a safe manner. Each passenger must have a seat, and the driver must abide by the 5 mile an hour speed limit. **Proof of insurance is required for all drivers.**

Pets with certificates of rabies vaccination are welcome. When outside, pets must be attended and leashed with a lead of 8 ft or less. Owners are to walk pets in the dog walk area and must clean up after their pets. Dogs must not be left outside unattended or left to bark.

Boats are not allowed on the pond after dark. **No one is to be in or on the water after dark.**

Campground paddleboats, kayaks and canoe are to be used respectfully and shared. Do not let them sit by your campsite. No diving off them or jumping off them. Lifejackets are required.

Piers are the private party of certain seasonal camper. Do not trespass!

Grey water is not to be released onto the ground.

Rule violators will be removed from the premises at the management's discretion. No alcohol consumption by minors is allowed. Any drunk or disorderly persons will be removed from the premises. No refunds will be granted if a camper is removed at management's discretion.
