

## ROY G. LAWRENCE

1912 - 1991

Roy G. Lawrence, age 78 of Pigeon, passed away Friday, February 8 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon.

He was born on October 19, 1912 in Caseville, the son of the late Frank and Julia (Grant) Lawrence. On November 5, 1933 he was united in marriage to Bernice L. Quick in Bay Port. She preceded him in death on December 4, 1984.

Mr. Lawrence retired in 1976 as manager of People's Oil & Gas of Pigeon. He was an active member of the Bay Port Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints and the Church District. A Charter Member and Past President of the Pigeon Lions Club, Mr. Lawrence also served as Governor of the Lions' District 11D in 1964. He was an honorary member of the Pigeon Chamber of Commerce, and was a Board Member of the Thumb Leisure Ministries.

Survivors include three daughters, Mrs. Jim (Shirley) Dubs of Bay Port, Mrs. Robert (Lucille) Ziel of Sebewaing, and Mrs. Ron (Janet) Heckman of Pigeon; 13 grandchildren; 10 great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a son, Wayne R. Lawrence, a sister, Isabel Hyzer, and an infant sister and brother.

Funeral Services will be conducted at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, February 11 from the Bay Port Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Elders Ervin Haley and Terry Brown will officiate with burial in the New Bay Port Cemetery.
