

# **EDWARD E. WIEDERHOLD**

## **1915 - 1996**

Edward E. Wiederhold, 79 of Elton, died Monday, April 17 at Vencor Hospital in Lincoln Park following a one-month illness.

He was born Aug. 3, 1915 in Oliver Township, the son of the late Mose and Lucille (LaClare) Wiederhold.

On Sept. 29, 1936, he was united in marriage to Hazel I. Bouverette in Elton. She preceded him in death Feb. 8, 1954. He later married Allean Forshee on Sept. 15, 1954. She also preceded him in death on Oct. 7, 1958.

Mr. Wiederhold and his brother Phil started Wiederhold Brothers, a trucking company in 1937 (currently Wiederhold Freight Lines). He semi-retired in 1984.

He was a member of the Community Wesleyan Church in Elton.
