

# **HARVEY C. PUFFPAFF**

**1908 - 1991**

Harvey C. Puffpaff, age 83 of Caseville, passed away Sunday, Nov. 24 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe.

He was born on Aug. 21, 1908 in Erin Township, Macomb County, son of the late Herman and Bertha S. (Jacob) Puffpaff. On May 16, 1931, he was united in marriage to Myrna M. Fields in Highland Park. Before his retirement in 1969, he was a police officer in East Detroit for 29 years.
