NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of .2683 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Shiner.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2020 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Shiner from the same properties in both the 2019 tax year and the 2020 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that City of Shiner may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate, unless the de minimis rate for City of Shiner exceeds the voter-approval tax rate for City of Shiner

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for City of Shiner, the rate that will raise \$500,000, and the current debt rate for City of Shiner

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that City of Shiner is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2020 tax year.

A public meeting to vote on the proposed tax rate will be held on September 02, 2020 at 6:00 PM at the Hoffie and Lank Wolters Shiner Public Library and Culture Center 115 E. Wolters/2nd Street Shiner TX 77984.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, City of Shiner is not required to hold an election at which voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the City Council of City of Shiner at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
