Making the Grade is a free supplemental program funded by a Title I grant that was created to help students meet the Common Core Standards. Guidelines for identification for this program include, but are not limited to, standardized testing from previous school years, current progress or report card grades and teacher recommendation.

Making the Grade consists of two independent programs in the subject areas of Math and Reading. Both programs will focus on lessons from the Buckle Down or Spectrum supplemental curriculum that are designed to align with Common Core standards in Math and Reading. Students in this program will work on mini lessons designed to align with the regular classroom curriculum.

The Making the Grade programs take place after school and usually with the regular homeroom teacher. **Both the Math and Reading programs are held on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays after school until 4:15pm. The first semester is from September 14, 2015 to December 11, 2015 and the second semester is from January 25, 2016 to May 5, 2016.**
