Associate Professor and Extension Specialist in soil and water dynamics at Clemson University. Her research-based extension focuses on water and soil relationships in turfgrass and row crop systems. She received her Ph.D. in 2006 from the Soil and Water Sciences Department of the University of Florida. During this time she conducted research on the environmental impacts of turfgrass management in South Florida. Her recent work includes irrigation water quality and quantity and the role of soil surfactants for turfgrass management and as a means to conserve freshwater resources.

Vicky Bertagnolli is the Consumer Horticulture Agent, Master Gardener Coordinator, and local "bug geek" in Aiken County. Vicky holds a B.S. in Wildlife Sciences from Auburn University, and an M.S. in Entomology from Auburn University.
